Master of Science (M.Sc.) & Degree from the partner university

The programme is partly completed at Neu-Ulm University of Applied Sciences and partly at a foreign partner university. With this double degree programme, graduates receive two degrees. If the double degree semester is completed at an Austrian partner university, three semesters will take place at HNU and one semester at the Austrian partner university (four semesters in total).

HOW INTERNATIONAL IS THIS PROGRAMME?

Neu-Ulm University of Applied Sciences promotes stays abroad through partnerships with universities worldwide. This Master's programme offers the unique opportunity of a double degree course, which is completed at one of the foreign partner universities. The Master's degree programme is an international course of study it is held exclusively in English.

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION?

- A university degree with a minimum of 210 ECTS credits is required.
 However, applicants who have a degree with 180 ECTS credits can make up the missing credits
- Bachelor's degree with an average mark of 2.5 or better
- · For international applicants: German A1
- English level B2 (proof required). Level C1 is recommended for applicants wishing to study abroad
- There are no restrictions on admission for this course
